This non-residential conference is for anyone on their journey of healing to become the person Jesus intends. The week is structured in such a way as to include training for those in leadership who wish to develop their spiritual insights into the needs of others as well as themselves.

The Healing Prayer School is an ecumenical based conference, founded on Anglican, charismatic, evangelical theology and doctrine, whilst continuing to explore creative use of the sacramental in its approach to wholeness. This ethos has found acceptance across most barriers between the denominations, churchmanship and language in both the UK and around Europe.

Lin Button has worked for more than thirty years in private practice and continues to research and develop healing prayer in the context of both conference teaching, prayer ministry and counselling.

Whilst the need for counselling and prayer ministry has become widely accepted over recent decades, Lin's conference and teaching ministry has experienced remarkable growth and seen increasing numbers of lives changed significantly.

Her heart is to impart a biblical understanding of the human condition and through the ministry of the Holy Spirit, to set people free on their journey to wholeness through the cross of Jesus.

Key to the expansion of this vision is the desire to train and equip church leaders, counsellors and others in ministry, and through their own experience of healing, enable them to effectively support and encourage others. Lin's widely respected ministry is supported by an experienced team of speakers and practitioners who work closely with her in presenting a variety of concordant material concerned with relational wholeness. In addition to her private practice and conference work, Lin is 'Pastoral Coordinator' on staff at the Anglican church of All Saints, Woodford Wells. She is married to Ron, has two sons and six grandchildren.

Whilst each conference has its own particular emphasis, the use of worship, prayer, poetry, sacrament and scripture combined with image and symbol remains central to each delegate's personal walk with Jesus.

TRAVEL

By road: From the M25 leave at Junction 26 and follow signs for Epping & Loughton A121 to Old Orleans roundabout. Take the 4th exit from the roundabout, sign posted A104 Woodford. Follow this road straight across the next roundabout and the following two sets of traffic lights. Past the Wells Toyota sales rooms (on your left) and at the end of a short dual carriageway turn immediately left into Inmans Row.

Approximately 6.5 miles from Central London the church is on the A104 toward Epping and only 5mins off the A406 North Circular Road at the Junction with the A104. On street parking outside the church is Pay & Display. Free parking is available a short distance across the green.

By rail: Woodford Station is on the London Underground Central Line and a 10min walk from the church. Local cabs are ready available at the station. The church is on the 20 bus route which connects at Walthamstow Central station with both the Victoria Line and main line services to Liverpool Street.

DAILY FORMAT

The conference starts at 9.30am each day and closes at approximately 5.15pm.
